


# **BODY**Shape and Proportions

• Wedge over a square




 Measured from sternum to ischium, and from wither to floor


- Elbow directly below rear edge of scapula
- **Body** depth (wither to elbow) is 44%; **Leg** (elbow to ground) is 56% of total height
- Head slightly longer than neck



- Pronounced wither
- Straight back
- Slightly sloping croup
- Loin as wide as it is long
- Foreleg and rear pastern vertical



- Forequarter approx.110-115 degrees
- Hindquarter approx.105-110 degrees



## **HEAD**

- Skull broad as wide across brow as long
- Planes slightly divergent, moderate stop
- Broad wedge muzzle, shorter than skull
- Medium, triangular ear, set on above eye





- Large, rounded eye, ochre to dark brown
- Bite scissor, level, reverse scissor one missing premolar allowed
- Length of **muzzle** 46%, length of **backskull** 56% of total head length



#### COAT

- Tight, even, ring-shaped or spiral curls
- Wooly, semi-rough, with visible undercoat Longer, looser curls on head
- Abundant eyebrows and beard
- Wavy on ears, edges trimmed to leather




#### Color:

- Off-white, all shades of brown, orange solids
- All shades of brown or orange roan
- Patch white with brown or orange patches
- Tan markings, white markings, darker mask and points allowed


### **Grooming:**

- No longer than 1.5 inches in a curled state
- Uniform with silhouette of dog, un-pretentious
- Accentuates the natural, rustic look
- Sculpted or blown out eliminates from competition

- Energetic trot with reach and drive
- Lively and balanced





# **DISQUALIFICATIONS**

- **Size-** Dogs under 16 ½ " or over 19 ½" . Bitches under 15 ½ " or over 18 ½"
- Walleye Eye with whitish iris, blue eye
- **Bite** Overshot or pronounced undershot (more than ½ inch)
- Teeth any missing tooth other than a premolar or more than one missing tooth
- **Dewclaws** Missing on front legs or present on rear legs
- Coat corded coat
- Color black coat, black patches or black pigmentation



The Lagotto Romagnolo is a small to medium sized dog with thick curly hair and a bright, happy demeanor. The breed originates from Italy and was first used to hunt waterfowl. Since the 19th century it has been specifically bred to hunt the underground tuber known as the truffle.
